### **“IN THE KINGDOM OF SIXTY-FOUR SQUARES, SAKSHAM REIGNS SUPREME”**

Saksham Wadhwa, a student of Std. IX-E, is an International Chess Player with many tremendous achievements. Being introduced to the game of 64 squares in 2019, Saksham managed to get his first international chess rating within a span of just 8 months. Being participant of many prestigious international tournaments, including events like the Dubai Open & the Rome Masters, he got the opportunity to compete against the finest chess players. One of his biggest achievements include earning a gold medal at the super-strong Abu Dhabi Chess Festival. As of January 2024, he has got the chance to participate in over 65 international rating tournaments in over 30 cities & 14 countries. Practicing for over 8 to 10 hours a day during the lockdown made him gain nearly 1000 rating points in just 18 months, jumping from 1100 to 2100 in classical ratings. In an international event in Serbia in July 2023, he gained a total of 553 rating points in both Rapid and Classical Chess formats. In December 2023, he had the opportunity to be a part of three of Europe's very strong events, the Sunway Sitges Chess Open, Barcelona, Rome Master, and the Rilton Cup in Stockholm, Sweden.
