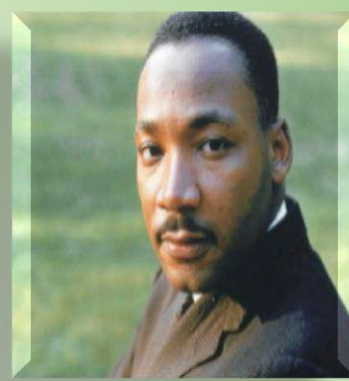
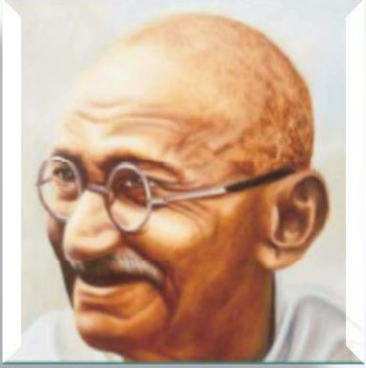

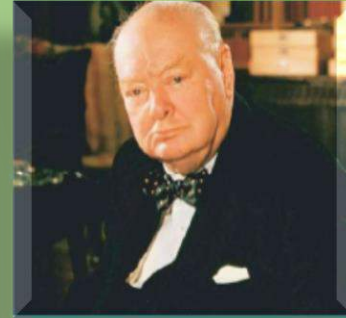

As a young man, Kanhaiyalal Maneklal Munshi was imbued with a sense of India's greatness. Not yet out of his teens, he learnt from his mother's songs and stories about the sages and seers of India's past. The heritage that these master-spirits represented was ingrained in the young Munshi deeply and later the incipient perception received an adult dimension. It would be instructive to remember that Kulpati Munshi founded the 'BHAVAN' a full decade before the advent of Independence. 7th of November 1938 was the beginning of an 'Adventure in Faith'. A faith in India's Past, Present and Future. The founding of Bhavan was based on the preservation and propagation of *Bharatiya Sanskriti* (Indian Culture) and Sanskrit, the mother of languages and the akshaya patra,- the inexhaustible reservoir. The unpretentious endeavour was backed by Kulpati Munshi's amazing pragmatism. Founded in 1938 by Dr. K.M. Munshi, Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan is today an All India Intellectual, Cultural and Educational movement dedicated to the twin task of interpreting the age old yet ageless message of our country and of integrating our varied and vibrant culture with the changing needs of the present-day world. During the six decades of its life the Bhavan has come to be recognized as a symbol of India's glorious past and as a comprehensive national institution with an international outlook touching all segments of life and enriching all spheres of activity.

Today Bhavan's has grown into a big tree with many schools in India and abroad. Bhavan's Bhagwandas Purohit Vidya Mandir, Civil Lines was established in 1982, having blossomed from humble beginnings, it has slowly and steadily gained respect and immense popularity.

RULES FOR PARTICIPATION:

- The competition is open to bonafide students of classes 8th and 9th of all recognized schools in Nagpur.
- Only two competitors from each school are allowed to participate in the contest. (One to speak for the motion and other to speak against the motion.)
- Participants shall be dressed in white uniform only.
- Each participant will be provided with a 'participant code' 2 days prior to the event.
- It is mandatory to pin the participant code to the uniform such that it is visible during the entire presentation.
- No participant is permitted to reveal his/her name and the name of the school.
- Any change in the details of the participants should be notified 2 days prior to the competition.
- The participants will join at least 15 mins. before the scheduled time.
- Participants should be well equipped with technology and trained to handle virtual sessions.
- No book, document or electronic gadget shall be allowed to the participant during the competition.



RULES FOR THE DEBATE

1. Each participant will be given 5 minutes to present his/her thoughts.
2. A warning bell will be rung at the completion of 4 minutes and the final bell at the end of 5 minutes.
3. Participants will not be judged after the completion of 5 minutes.
4. Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
5. Time taken by every individual speaker will be recorded by the host school's stopwatch for the purpose of record keeping. No other form of time keeping will be entertained on any account.
6. Bhavan's Munshi Memorial Inter School Debate Competition will be judged on the basis of the following criteria:
 - a) Knowledge of subject
 - b) Presentation - organization, voice modulation and proper sequence
 - c) Refutation - analysis
 - d) Platform manners and ethical consideration
 - e) Relevance and evidence - substantiation with evidence
7. A panel of 3 judges will assess the performance of the participants. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.



PRIZES

- The Bhavan's Munshi Memorial Inter School Debate Rolling Trophy will be awarded to the school on the basis of the cumulative total scored by their team.
- Besides the trophy, individual prizes will be awarded to each winner as follows



- First Prize - Cup with cash prize of Rs. 500/-
- Second Prize - Cup with cash prize of Rs. 400/-
- Third Prize - Cup with cash prize of Rs. 300/-
- Upcoming Debater Award - Cup with cash prize of Rs. 300/-

Note:The winner of the competition will retain the rolling trophy till the next debate competition and will be responsible for its maintenance and safe return. It will be the responsibility of the winning school to return the trophy at their own cost to the Principal, Bhavan's Bhagwandas Purohit Vidya Mandir, Civil Lines, Nagpur by 15th December of the same year.
