APPLICATION FOR AFFILIATION OF INSTITUTIONS

FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL EXAMINATION

PRELIMINARY NOTES

Before filling up the form, please go through the following notes which indicate, in general terms, certain terms and conditions, (the full details are given in the Board's Handbook for Affiliation) which the school must fulfil, in order to be considered for affiliation of the secondary classes (IX-X)

1. Request for approval will be entertained only if the school intends to add classes till at least the secondary stage (class X) is reached.
2. Application, in the prescribed form, should reach the Board's office, latest by 31st August of the year *preceding* the session from which approval is sought for beginning class IX.
3. Application must be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 300/- through a Bank Draft or Cash to be remitted in favour of the Secretary of the Board.
4. Application will be considered only when a 'No Objection Certificate' is obtained from the Competent Authority of State Department of Education or, alternately, when the form is countersigned by the Department and forwarded.
5. Application for approval of Institutions situated *Outside* India should be sent through the Indian Diplomatic Mission in that country and should carry recommendation by the Mission.
6. Adequate School Plant, and facilities for physical education should exist,
7. School should possess a good stock of books in the Library (Minimum : 1500).
8. The staff should be qualified and trained according to the norms prescribed by the Board.
9. The conditions of service including salaries and allowances paid to different categories of staff should be *at least on a par with* those in Government institutions of the State.
10. The School should be financially viable.
11. The Academic Session should correspond to what obtains in the other Schools of the Board, namely from May to April of the following year.
12. Grant of affiliation will be given after the school has been inspected by an Inspection Committee set up by the Board.
13. The charging of very high fees (disproportionate to the facilities offered), charging of capitation fee or getting forced donations are considered serious offences and will endanger continuance of affiliation.
