APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF MIDDLE CLASS SYLLABUS


PRELIMINARY NOTES

Before filling up the form, please go through the following notes which indicate, in general terms, certain terms and conditions (the full details are given in the Board's Handbook for Affiliation) which the School must fulfill, in order to be considered for approval of middle class syllabus.

1. Request for approval will be entertained only when the School has started at least class VI.
2. Application, in the prescribed form should reach the Board's office, latest by 31st August of the year preceding the session from which approval is sought.
3. Application must be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 300/- through a Bank Draft or Cash to be remitted in favour of the Secretary of the Board.
4. Application will be considered only when a 'No Objection Certificate' is obtained from the State Department of Education or alternately, when the form is countersigned by the Department.
5. Application for approval of Institutions situated outside India should be sent through the Indian Diplomatic Mission in the country and should carry recommendation by the Mission.
6. Adequate School Plant and facilities should exist.
7. School should possess a good stock of books in the Library.
8. The staff should be qualified and trained according to the norms prescribed.
9. The conditions of service including salaries and allowances paid to different categories of staff should be at least at par with those in Government Institutions of the State.
10. The School should be financially viable.
11. The School should have plans to add new classes till at least the Secondary Class (Class-X) is reached.
12. The Academic Session should correspond to what obtains in the other Schools of the Board, namely from May to April.
13. Accord of approval will be given after the School has been inspected by an Inspection Committee set up by the Board and on the basis of its report.




